The Members of the Tranquility Bay RV Park Cooperative are pleased to welcome you to our campground.

Keep in mind you are registered as a guest of one of our members and as such they are ultimately responsible for all of your actions.

**While you are here we ask that you respect a few simple rules**

**ARRIVAL:**

- All camping fees must be paid in advance
- The Park Manager will assign you a campsite, please do not park before checking in.
- Powered site can use either 20 amp or 30 amp services - not both
- Non-powered site - no power is available
  - Non-powered sites are not able to run an extension cord to powered sites & no generators are allowed as per TBC rules.

**NO TOLERANCE:**

- Any vandalism, theft, willful damage in the park will result in immediate expulsion.
- Any disrespect to Park Managers could also result in immediate expulsion. The member responsible for you could have their access to the park revoked because of your actions.

**DRIVING:**

- All roads in Tranquility Bay are one-way and clearly marked. Speed Limit – 15 km/hour.
  - Our roads are not large enough to accommodate two way traffic.
- Goose Boulevard is two-way traffic. Speed limit - 20 km/hr
- Users of any motorized vehicle (gas or electric) within the park must have, at minimum, a valid Alberta Class 7 operator's license (or equivalent for non-Alberta residents). Unlicensed users must be accompanied by a person with a valid Alberta Class 5 or greater operator's license (or equivalent for non-Alberta residents).
- The use of quads, side-by-sides & gas powered golf carts will also be prohibited during park quiet hours of 11:00 pm – 9:00 am. Vehicles & electric/battery operated golf cart can be used at anytime
- Do not drive across any of the grassed areas. With exception is the day camp area as directed by the Park Managers.
- Vehicles, including ATV's, golf carts, motorcycles, etc are not permitted on the sand in the swimming beach area

**PARKING VEHICLES:**

- No parking vehicles and trailers in the boat launch area
- Day parking is available partly down the hill to the boat launch
- Overnight parking is available just North & East of the Owls Nest.

**PETS:**

- Pets must be on a leash at all time or controlled within your campsite
- Please pick up all pet deposits left by your pet in all areas of the park & put them into garbage bins.
- Pets are not permitted on the swimming area beach. They are welcome to swim north of the boat launch. Again they must be controlled.

**BOATS/BEACH AREA:**

- The dock is for loading and unloading only.
- Boats must not be tied to the dock and left there unattended for any length of time.
- Boats may be tied to the pilings north of the boat launch.
- No dogs or glass or motorized vehicles including golf carts are permitted in the swimming area beach.

If you leave the park, secure your belongings, roll up canopies etc. as extreme gusty winds arise frequently here. Please wrap and tie all garbage, to be placed in the main trash bin.
